In the last three years the voters of Scottsdale have organized to protect the Preserve from commercial development, elected citizen-friendly City Council candidates by unprecedented margins and fought toxic overdevelopment in Downtown. I am proud to have been a part of those efforts.

All of this activism makes it clear Scottsdale citizens want a change from the current policy of toxic overdevelopment pursued by our current City Council majority, including by the two currently announced candidates for Mayor.
