## **Littlefield Earns PFFA Support For Scottsdale Mayor**

Former three-term City Councilman Bob Littlefield has earned the endorsement of the Professional Fire Fighters of Arizona in his bid for Scottsdale mayor.

Littlefield, who served on the City Council from 2002-2014, has been a long-time supporter of Scottsdale Firefighters, including their compensation issues and helping provide fire and emergency services personnel with the resources they need to perform their duties for citizens and the millions of tourists who visit Scottsdale every year.

“There has not been an elected official in the Valley more loyal to firefighters’ causes and issues than Bob Littlefield,” according to Bryan Jeffries, president of the PFFA. “For our organization, loyalty goes both ways. That’s why our organization is endorsing Bob for mayor of Scottsdale.”

In 2003 Littlefield was the only councilmember to support the effort to convert Scottsdale’s privately-run fire department into a municipally-run department. The city established its municipal fire department in 2005.

Littlefield’s wife, Kathy, currently serves on the Scottsdale City Council. She is serving her first term in that office.
